

CGRS GARDEN COMMITTEE
REPORT FOR AGM. July 2009

Work done since September 2008:

Extensive planting of shrubs and ground cover .

House numbers:

- 1) large fatsia planted and ground cover plants.
- 8) old shrubs and stumps removed and new shrubs planted and turf.
- 10) 3 shrubs planted.
- 11) 3 rosemary planted.
- 12) existing shrubs pruned.
- 16) 1shrub planted
- 17 and 18) 5 shrubs planted at front
- 18,19) laurels planted outside back.
- 19) fatsia planted at front.
- 22) turf laid.
- 23) hydrangeas planted.

At the top of the green, by the side of 23 laurels, ceanothus and mahonia shrubs have been planted to form a thicker hedge to screen the road. Three dead viburnum and their stumps have been removed and replaced with mahonia. Grass has been seeded under the Corner Green sign.

Trees

2 dead birch trees have removed from the side of no.1 and another dead birch has been removed from the front of 22.

We are at present organising a tree survey so that we are aware of any more dying or unsafe trees. We have received a quote from Dolwin and Gray for the survey and are awaiting approval from the directors. Once this has been carried out, Derek Ellis will be able to recommend an overall planting and tree plan and present it at an EGM.

We are suffering from honey fungus in the top area of the green and Derek Ellis has produced a report on how to manage this.
